

### Chelsea doctor loses place on bench

Chelsea team doctor Eva Carneiro lost her place on the bench in the match against Manchester City. She lost her place because Jose Mourinho said that she was "naive" and did not understand the game.

Carneiro will continue to be Chelsea's first-team doctor but she will not be on the bench during matches or trainings. She will work with first-team players only at Cobham training ground.

On Sunday, during the match Chelsea vs Swansea, the Chelsea goalkeeper Thibaut Courtois was sent off on 52 minutes. Then Eva Carneiro ran on to treat Hazard and he had to leave the pitch and so Chelsea were down to nine men for a while.

"I was unhappy with my medical staff. They were impulsive and naive," said Mourinho.

A lot of people supported Carneiro on Twitter and Facebook and yesterday she thanked them. This made Mourinho even angrier and he decided that Eva Carneiro must not be on the bench.
